As always make sure that there are enough adults per child and that you have your first aid kits, registers, permission slips (if applicable) and emergency contact details for parents, carers and children with you. If you have any queries, please speak to your Support Worker or contact the SPELL office. Above all make sure you have fun.

First Aid Kits
